Arriving parents will need to wait your turn 6' apart. One child at a time. Parents ring bell at gate. Child and parent' temperature will be taken. Sign sign in sheet is at the gate. Parents and children needs to wear masks. Please bring one for morning, one for afternoon. They get wet. Parents need to disinfect their child's shoes at the gate. Good byes are at the gate. Child puts their bag in their cubbies and washes hand. Only one child at a time in the bathroom. Children play arms length apart. Not touching. Each child play in one area at a time, arms length away from each other. In other words one child at one easel at a time. Two child per water play bins. Two child at a swings and slides at a time. Two child in a play house at a time. Two child in the play kitchen area at a time. Children go one at a time into the bathroom. Children go one at a time into the bathroom. Each child will have their own table/ chair separated by 3' for

	 eating, writing and art. 13. Each child will sleep on a cot separated by 6'. 14. Bring extra cloths, but nothing else. We want to limit the amount of things coming from home. Like water bottles toys etc We provide water. 15. All students wash hands before eating. Bathrooms are cleaned everyday. Tables are sterilized before and after every meal. Dishes are sterilized in dish washer. Preschool is cleaned everyday. Fresh water is put in water play everyday. Bedding is washed every week. All toys and play areas are cleaned. 16. Pick up: Please ring bell. Sign the in sheet at the gate. We will bring your child out. Keep 6' from anyone else picking up. 17. If a child has a cold or some other illness they need to be tested and return with not symptoms. 18. If a child is exposed to Covid or has covid, they need to be tested and can't return for 10 -14 days. The preschool will close everyone needs to tested. Preschool will be disinfected. Preschool will reopen when all teacher test negative in 3 days. Students who test negative may return.
